It takes a lot of hands to prepare Lutherlyn for the thousands of people who will visit throughout the spring and summer. In addition to our quickly approaching Summer Camp programs, Lutherlyn also hosts thousands of people who visit on Environmental Education field trips, participate in Adventure and team building programs, and take lessons at the Equestrian Center.

Flower beds need to be weeded, firewood needs to be cut, fences need to be repaired, sticks and leaves need to be removed, as well as a variety of other jobs for volunteers of all ages and skill levels.

Lutherlyn provides all of the tools (and a lunch prepared by Chef Lisa) and our volunteers provide the willing hands!

We are looking for responsible chainsaw owners to bring a chainsaw and cut up some down trees for us. You can take logs with you to split for firewood.

We can't do it without you!

- There are tasks for volunteers of all ages and skill levels
 - Volunteers can be individuals, families, or groups of all kinds. If you are part of a group who would like to tackle a project together please let us know ahead of time. Please provide an approximate number of people in your group and what level of physical activity would be a good fit (or any special construction skills you may have) so we select a project and gather the necessary tools and supplies.
- Snacks and lunch are provided
- Examples of Work Day projects include:
 - raking and blowing leaves
 - picking up sticks (this is an enormous help before spring mowing begins!)
 - splitting wood
 - clearing leaves and tidying the amphitheater
 - removing sticks and placing mulch around ropes course elements
 - removing weeds at the beach of lower lake

Directions:

- Lutherlyn is located 40 miles north of Pittsburgh off of Route 422 between Butler and Prospect. The best routes to Route 422 are Interstate 79 or Route 8.
- Please only enter Lutherlyn's grounds via our main entrance from Dick Road. If you're using GPS our physical address is 500 Lutherlyn Lane, Butler, PA 16001.
- Upon arrival please visit the office to notify us of your visit.
- **From the West:** Take Interstate 79 to Route 422 (the Butler/New Castle exit) and head east 8.2 miles. Make a right hand turn at the 84 Lumber onto Dick Road. The main entrance to the camp is 1.5 miles down the road. The camp driveway will take you directly to the main parking lot and the camp office.
- **From the East:** Take Route 8 to Route 422 and head west (towards New Castle) 7 miles to the 84 Lumber. Make a left hand turn on to Dick Road. The main entrance is 1.5 miles down the road. The camp driveway will take you directly to the main parking lot and the camp office.
- To ensure the safety of all guests, staff members, and volunteers please let us know in advance if you would like to visit. All guests are required to sign in at the office. For further information or different directions, please contact Lutherlyn at 724-865-2161 or email@lutherlyn.com.
